## CODE OF CONDUCT

This code of conduct will serve as a guideline of behaviour for all coaches, managers, players, parents and spectators. It is applicable to **training sessions, trial matches, competition matches and any other tournament** that a team takes part in as a representative of Loftus-Yarrawarrah Soccer Club Inc.

- 1. All parties will act with courtesy, respect and discipline when dealing with other people from within our Club, any other club or representatives of the S.S.J.S.F.A. (The District Association).
- 2. A fair sporting attitude is expected from all those involved in, or as spectators at, any game or training activity.
- 3. The following behaviour is unacceptable and will not be tolerated by this Club:
  - Foul and abusive language.
  - Intimidating or threatening behaviour.
  - Calling out of derogatory comments to players or officials.
  - The consumption of alcohol at any junior game (Saturdays) or excessive consumption of alcohol at any senior game (Sundays).
- 4. Only the coach or manager of a team is allowed to approach a referee about any problem that occurs on or off the field.
- 5. The abuse or destruction of Club property.

If you feel it necessary to report any circumstance that contravene the above guidelines, whether by a member of our club or any other club, a form will be available from either your manager or the Loftus Oval Canteen. All reports will be treated confidentially, but the committee will disregard any "anonymous" submissions.

Return the completed report to your manager or leave it at the Loftus Oval Canteen.

Please note that the committee does have the right, under the Club's Articles of Association, to temporarily or permanently suspend any member found to have breached the Code of Conduct. In the case of parents or spectators, this will impact on any registered player from within that family.
